


Individual registered adult members of the BSA can print a membership ID card for each position they are currently registered for through the [My.Scouting.org](http://My.Scouting.org) web site. You can print your membership ID card for proof of registration as a Merit Badge Counselor, a Unit Commissioner, or a Scoutmaster. You can print a membership ID card for every position you hold, should you wish to.

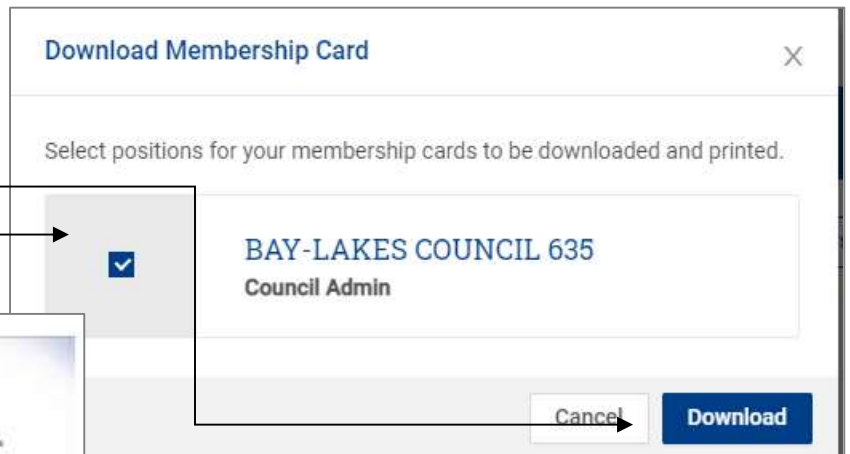
The following instructions will help you navigate through the [My.Scouting.org](http://My.Scouting.org) website so you can print your personal membership ID card today.

### HOW TO PRINT YOUR INDIVIDUAL BSA MEMBERSHIP CARD(S)?

1. Log into your account at: [My.Scouting.org](http://My.Scouting.org)
2. On the Home Screen, Click on the  **Menu** button (upper left corner)  
→ Click on **My Profile**
3. On the My Profile screen, scroll down to the Registrations section



4. Click **Download Membership Card**
5. A Download Membership Card box opens, Click the **Check Box** for each position for which you would like a membership card
6. Click **Download**
7. A PDF document with your membership card(s) will download, open this file
8. Print the membership ID card(s) for each position you hold
