TAX EFFICIENT STRATEGIES

APPRECIATED STOCK DONATIONS:

Donating your assets that have increased in value, such as stock holdings, means avoiding capital gains tax on that asset, which otherwise would have to be paid at your sale of the asset.

GIFTING FROM RETIREMENT ACCOUNTS:

Donating dollars from your pre-tax retirement accounts, such as your Traditional IRA account, means avoiding all ordinary income tax on those funds you donate, which otherwise would have been taxed at ordinary income rates on every dollar you withdraw.

You can start donating funds from your Traditional IRA to Bay-Lakes Council after you turn 70.5 years old. Starting as early as age 73 (75 for some individuals depending on date of birth), you have required minimum distributions (RMD) from your Traditional IRAs. Donating those RMD amounts wipes out the tax you would have been required to pay if you withdrew those dollars yourself.

Checks from your pre-tax retirement accounts can be sent to the Bay-Lakes Council via these instructions: Payable to Bay-Lakes Council, Boy Scouts of America.

Mailed to Bay-Lakes Council, Boy Scouts of America at 2555 Northern Road, Appleton, WI 54914.

You can also name Bay-Lakes Council as the beneficiary for your pre-tax retirement account if you'd like it to be donated at your passing. This would mean no tax on these dollars at your passing, compared to the individual's inheriting having to pay ordinary income rates on every dollar they withdraw.

GIVING FROM DONOR ADVISED FUND:

Bunching multiple years of planned giving to Bay-Lakes Council into a Donor Advised Fund, can maximize your itemized tax deduction. You can then donate to Bay-Lakes Council directly from your Donor Advised Fund.
