

## Bay-Lakes and Samoset Council Jamboree Contingent WHITEWATER RAFTING REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

The jamboree's River Rafting experience offers rafting on three sections of the scenic New River – which is the oldest river in North America! The sections of the New River will be Class I – III+ rapids. Each raft has a professional river guide provided by local outfitters.

This is a half day River Rafting experience on the lower New River in the New River Gorge National Park. In the half day trip, your contingent members will outfit a large rubber raft boat up to 8 individuals per boat to navigate 10 miles of river. You will navigate approximately 25 different rapids ranging between Class 1 to Class 4+. You will spend roughly an hour and half to two hours on the water.

River Rafting does NOT close due to weather, including thunderstorms. The cost is \$125 per person.

TIME TO COMPLETE: 4 to 6 hours depending on water level.

This is an optional activity during the Jamboree. It will be scheduled during one of the program days.

Participation requires pre-registration and approval by the local council. Walk in participation is not an option. Also required is a permission waiver, authorized/signed by a parent/guardian, completed, and submitted when you register.

## Registration steps.

- 1. Download the rafting <u>permission waiver</u>, fill out with parent/guardian signature. Then scan the waiver and save it for attaching to the registration form.
